small boy named Cory.



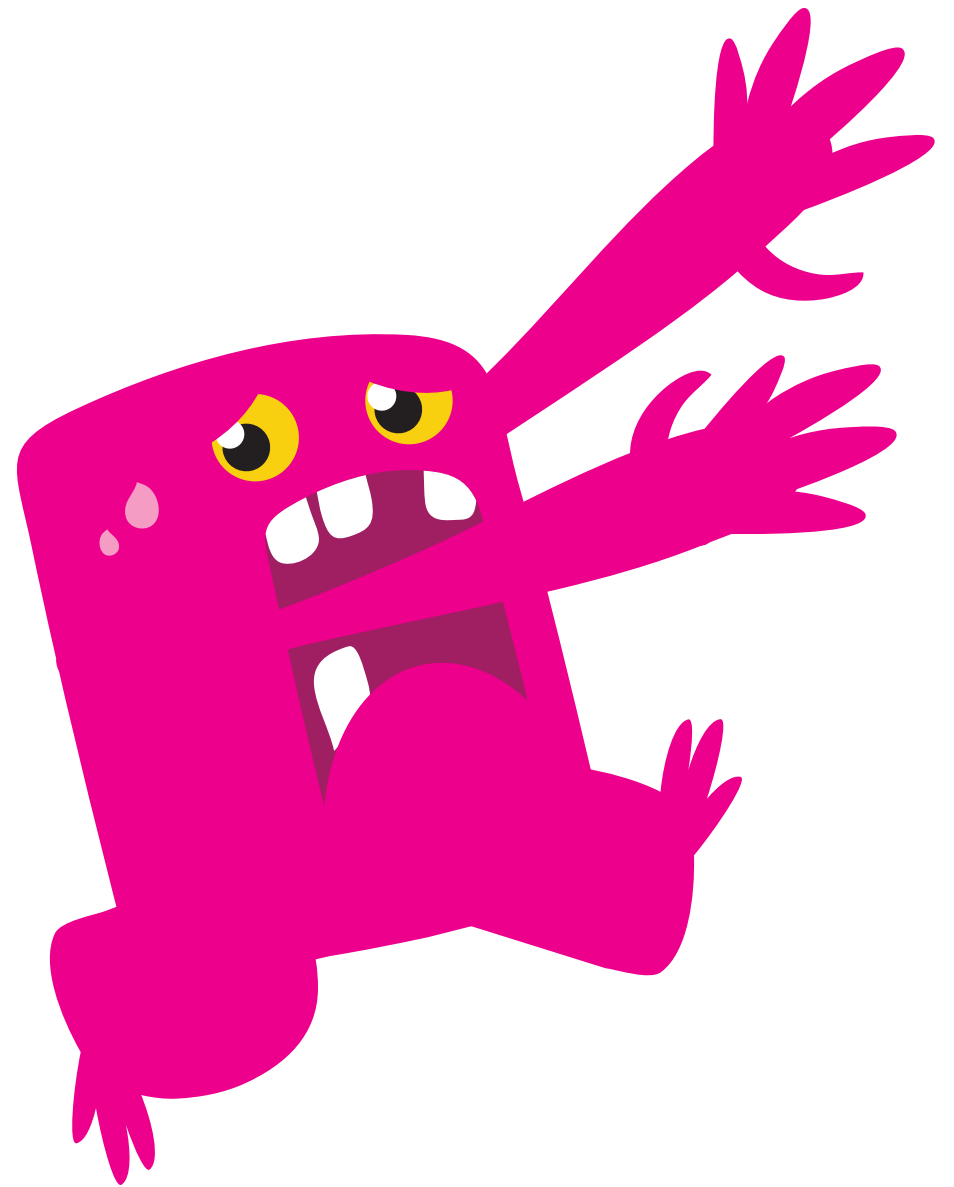
Cory was just like every other little boy,  
except for one thing...



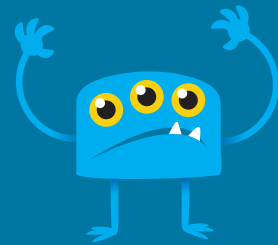
Cory fought giants.



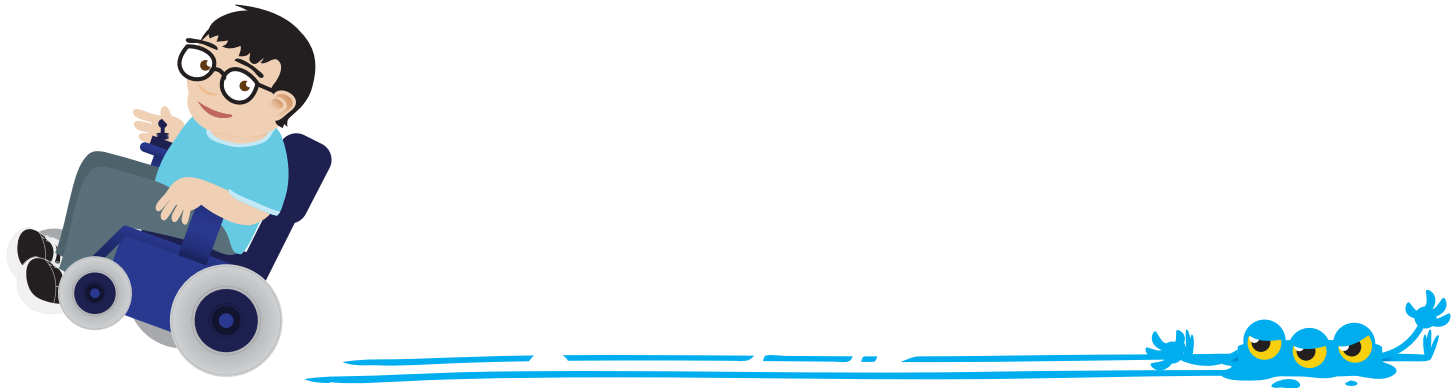
There were big giants



and Cory fought them.



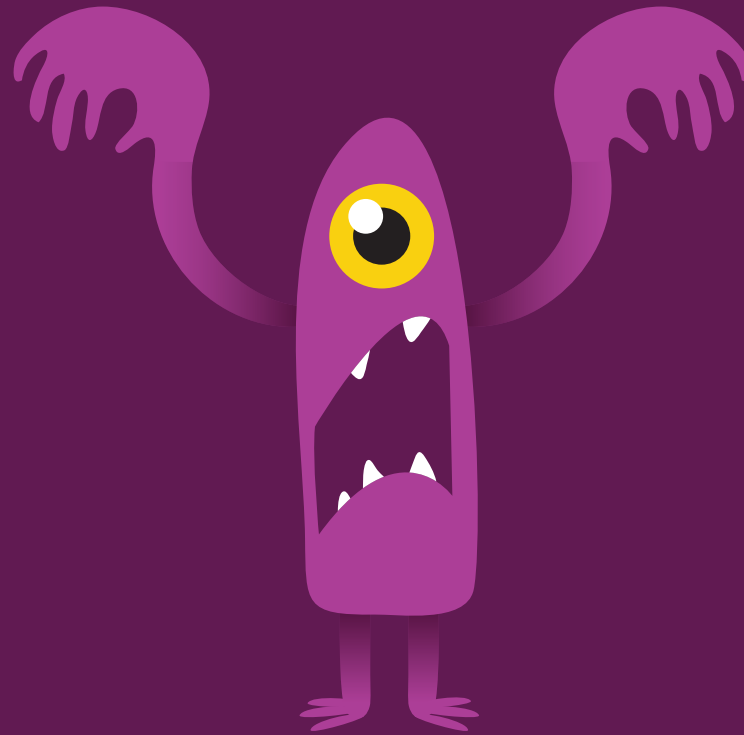
There were little giants



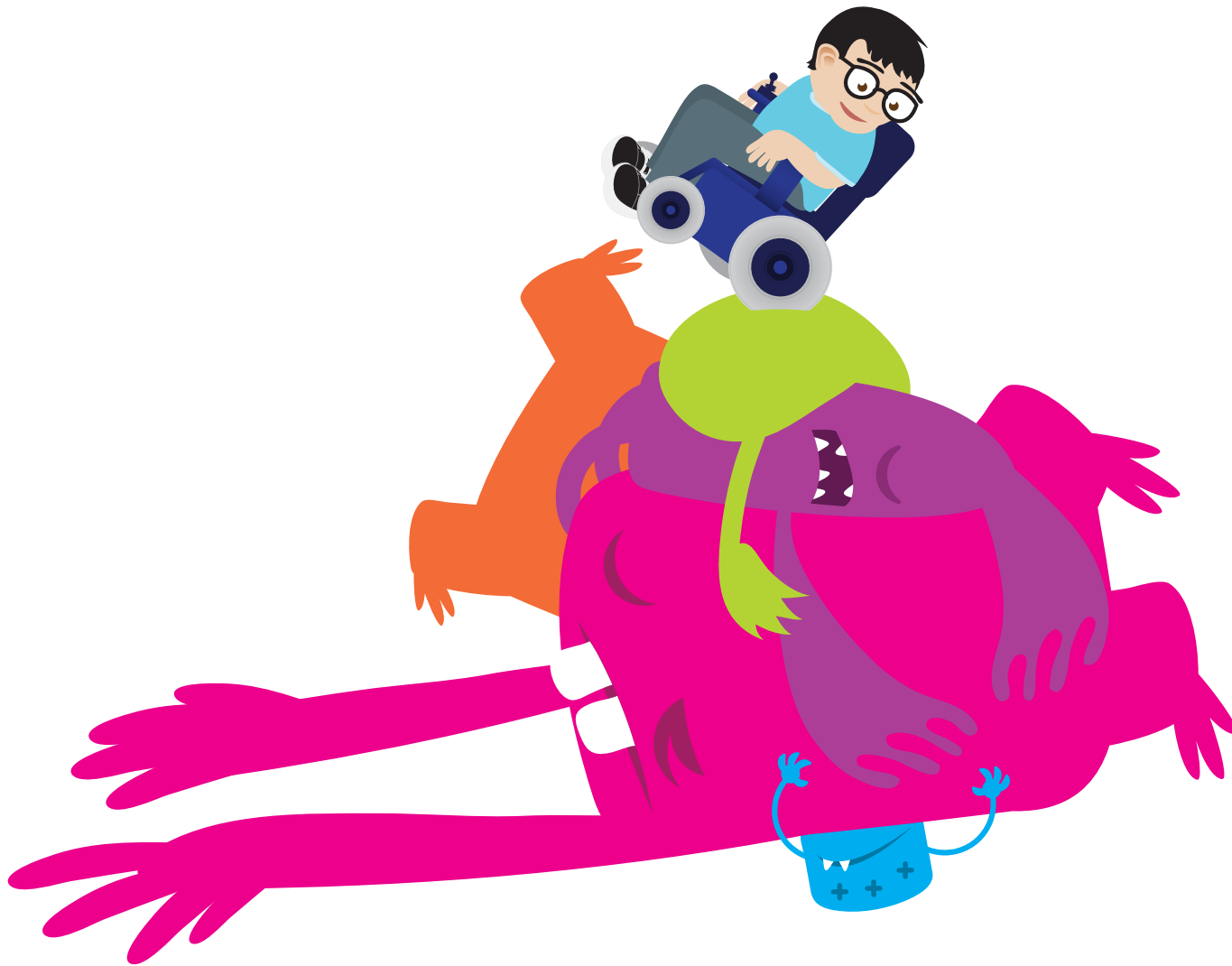
and Cory fought them.

and Cory fought them all.

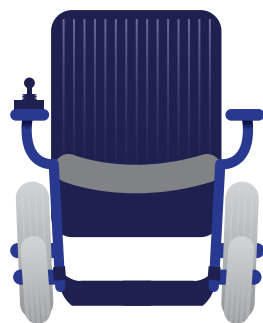


Every day and every night Cory fought the giants
